THIS DEED, made this 25±4 day of September, 1945, by and between the United States of America (hereinafter called the "Government"), acting by and through the Federal Works Administrator (hereinafter called the "Administrator"), and the City of Houston, Texas, a municipal corporation, body politic and corporate created and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas (hereinafter called the "City"):

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Public No. 849, 76th Congress, approved October 14, 1940, as amended by Public Law 42, 77th Congress, approved April 29, 1941, Public Law 137, 77th Congress, approved June 28, 1941, Public Law 409, 77th Congress, approved January 21, 1942, Public Law 522, 77th Congress, approved April 10, 1942, Public Law 119, 78th Congress, approved July 7, 1943, Public Law 150, 78th Congress, approved July 15, 1943, and Public Law 279, 78th Congress, approved April 1, 1944 (hereinafter called the "Act"), the Government has acquired certain water facilities known as the "West Canal" and being a part of the Earris County War Industries Water Supply, Project No. Tex. 41-564, located in the northeastern part of Harris County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority conferred by the Act, the Government has agreed to sell to the City and the City has agreed to purchase from the Government the aforesaid West Canal upon terms which the Administrator deems to be in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Government has agreed to transfer to the City all of the Government's right, title and interest in and to such West Canal:

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Government, in consideration of the premises and the payment to it by the City of the sum of Nine Hundred Thirty-seven Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty-nine Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$937,959.80) in cash, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and an additional amount (herein called "additional amount") equal to the difference (in no event to exceed Sixty-four Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$64,950.20)) between Sixty Thousand, Forty-nine Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$60,049.80) included in the above-mentioned

cash payment of Nime Hundred Thirty-seven Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty-nine .

Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$937,959.80) and the actual cost to the Government of a perpetual easement for two 30-inch water lines in a certain tunnel under the Houston Ship Channel, and perpetual easements across lands adjoining said tunnel, said tunnel and lands being more fully described in "Exhibit A" attached and made a part hereof (such additional amount to be paid by the City to the Government within ten days from the date of acquisition of such perpetual easements by conveyance or within ten days from the effective date of final judgment if acquired by condemnation), does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the City of Houston, Texas, all the Government's right, title and interest in and to said West Canal and in and to the following described real property, easements, rights-of-way, and improvements thereon:

WR-6, WR-7, WR-8, WR-9, WR-10, WR-11, WR-12, WR-13, WR-14, WR-15, WR-16 and WR-17 as the same are shown and described on the attached plats and maps of said parcels, together with all improvements, structures, and appurtenances constructed in and on said land by the Government and including but not restricted to: river pumping station, including building, pumping units and pipe connections; force mains; roadways; fencing; bridges; canals; siphons; drainage ditches; reservoir with levees, dikes and spillways; channel pumping plant, including building, pumping units, and pipe connections; force mains across the Champion Paper and Fibre Company lands, both north and south of the Houston Ship Channel, together with force mains or siphons and appurtenances in and through the tunnel under the Houston Ship Channel; metering facilities, equipment and meter house; and any and all appurtenant structures and facilities. The estates and interests in said lands herein conveyed are the respective estates and interests of the Government in and to the above-described parcels acquired by condemnation proceedings in

the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division, in Civil Action numbers 898, 958, 979, 981, 1017, 1024, 1029, 1040, 1045, 1050, 1055, 1059, 1128, 1132, 1148, 1150, 1157, 1177, 1188, 1409 and 1917.

The City is fully advised as to the Government's obligations to furnish water necessary for war industries in the vicinity of the West Canal and of the existing contracts by which the Government is obligated to furnish such water, and this conveyance is conditioned that the City will furnish water in sufficient quantities, if available, to the war industries now existing, or that may hereafter be established during the existence of the emergency which was declared by the President to exist on September 8, 1939, and for six months thereafter, or for the periods of time set forth in any existing contracts, whichever is longer, and the City agrees to accept assignment of all such contracts and the City agrees to fully perform same. This conveyance is further conditioned that the Government, through its duly authorized representatives, shall have the right for the duration of the present emergency and six months thereafter, and for the duration of any and all existing contracts with consumers, at any reasonable time, to enter upon and inspect the West Canal, and should it be determined that adequate quantities of water are not being supplied war industries, the Government, through its duly authorized representatives, may repossess said West Canal for the duration of the present emergency and six months thereafter, and for the duration of existing contracts with consumers, during which period of operation by the Government, the revenue arising from the operation of the West Canal shall be collected by the Government should it take possession hereunder, and such revenues shall first be applied to the cost of maintenance and operation of the West Canal and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the City.

Provided, however, that it is contemplated that the City or other public body in cooperation with the City will erect a dam, reservoir and appurtenances on the San Jacinto River which will be used in lieu of the existing pumping plant constructed by the Government and when said improvements have been constructed and/or placed in operation by the City or such other public body, then the City shall deliver the machinery and equipment described in "Exhibit B" made a part hereof to the Government in as good condition and state of repair as such machinery and equipment is in when delivered to the City, ordinary wear and tear or damage caused by storms, floods, or acts of God or by war, the public enemy, sabotage,

riots or unavoidable accidents alone excepted. Said machinery and equipment described in "Exhibit B" shall be removed from the building now housing same at the expense of the Government, but must be so removed within sixty days from the date the City notifies the Government that such machinery and equipment are no longer needed by the City.

Provided further, that a vendor's lien is retained against the hereinabove described West Canal and all other property herein described for the security and until the full and final payment of the above described additional amount, when and whereupon this deed shall become absolute.
