 made our promissory note and do so execute it as follows "On the tenth day of October 1869 we promise
 to pay or order the sum of One thousand four hundred and 60/100 dollars in legal tender U.S. Treasury
 notes for value received with interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date of this instrument the
 of said note being for money advanced and paid by the said J. E. Foster for the benefit of the separate
 property of the said Rebecca Stanley and for the support and maintenance of the said Rebecca Stanley
 and her children and we sign this note on the second day of September 1869 and make it a
 part of this deed J. P. Stanley Rebecca Stanley & her mark Attest R. H. Stearns now we being
 of sound mind and memory unto the said J. E. Foster the payment of said note at maturity
 and said interest due thereon to the assigns of the said J. E. Foster in consideration thereof a
 in consideration of ten dollars to us paid by James F. Dumble have this day granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said James F. Dumble for
 purposes hereinafter stated the following described property in the State of Texas and County
 Harris to wit a portion of the Sam L. Harris tract marked and designated upon Russell Scott
 Map of the City of Houston to which reference is made for a more perfect com-
 munity at Paul Street on the North Margin of Buffalo Bayou thence up the meanderings of said
 to the extreme South corner of the J. P. Judd's tract according to said map thence with said J.
 P. Judd's tract to the East corner of the C. S. Stenger tract as marked on my map thence East to Paul Street
 thence South along Paul Street to place of beginning on the way or being the same property
 by W. P. McGowan to J. P. Stanley by deed recorded in Vol 2 page 98 Harris County Records

 living conditions in case we shall well and truly pay the said note and interest due thereon to a
 holder thereof within the time shall become due from this deed and all herein contained to be null and
 void of default in the payment of said note and interest or any part thereof when the same shall
 and payable then it shall be held by the said James F. Dumble trustee at any time after such default
 of the legal holder of said note unpaid to sell said property at the Court House door of Harris
 to the highest bidder for cash at public auction first giving at least twenty days notice of the time place
 and terms of sale in some newspaper published in the County of Harris until to make execute and
 to the purchaser or purchasers of such property a good and sufficient deed or deeds for such prop-
 erty and such deed or deeds transfer when so made by said trustee we bind ourselves our heirs
 and Administrators to warrant and forever defend and the deeds or deeds so given by said trustee
 we do hereby declare ~~and~~ ^{in full force} evidence against us that all the prerequisites and
 covenants of this instrument have been fully and fairly complied with and we do hereby declare that
 this day and do this day give actual possession of all of said property to the said trustee and he is
 authorized to give the purchaser or purchasers under this deed full possession of said property and if
 or either of us should happen to be in possession of any of said property after the sale then we here
 that we are and shall be deemed tenants at sufferance of the purchaser or purchasers and ha-
 ejectment by writ of forcible delivery and we further declare that the trustee empowered to be en-
 titled to sell at private sale before the maturity of said note and apply the proceeds to the payment
 of said note to be made however with the concurrence of the legal holder of said note and of a

 presence for the purposes and considerations therein stated and done willingly and that as
