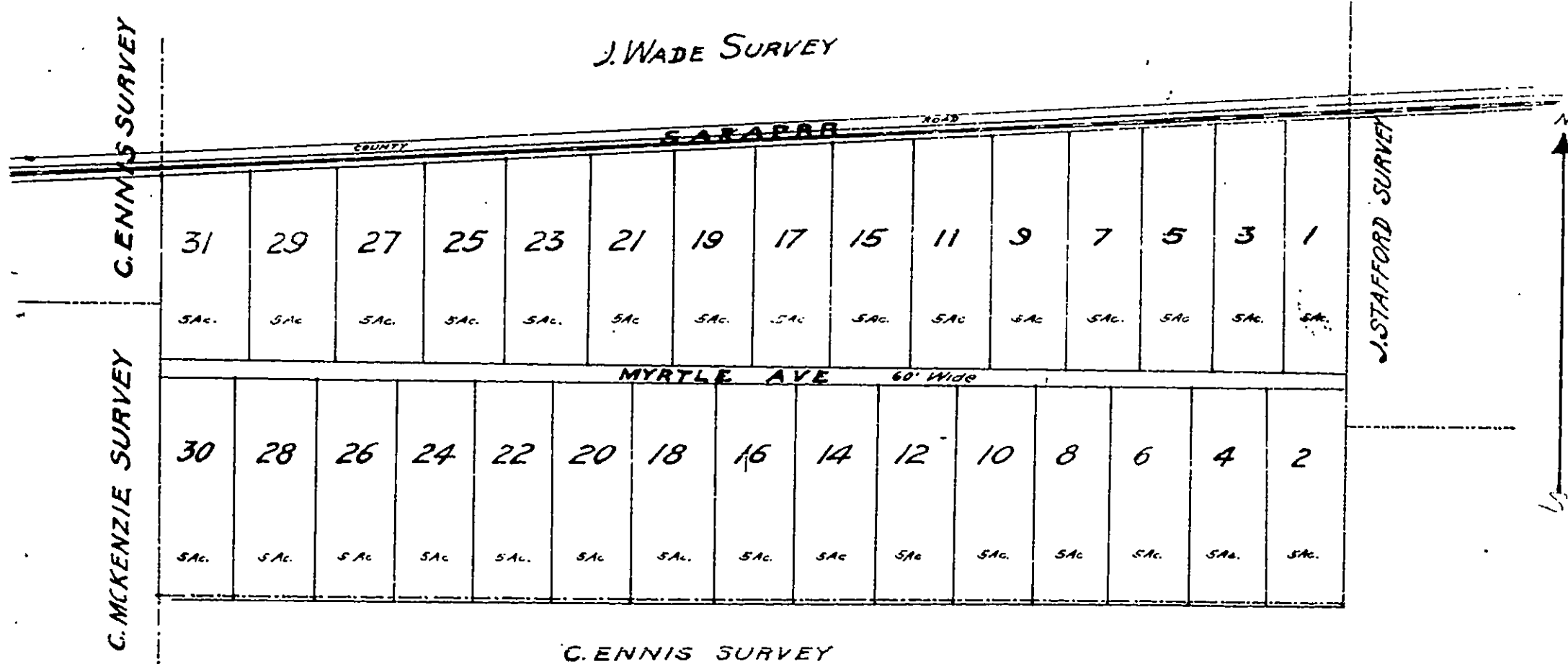


MAP OF DUNNRIDGE

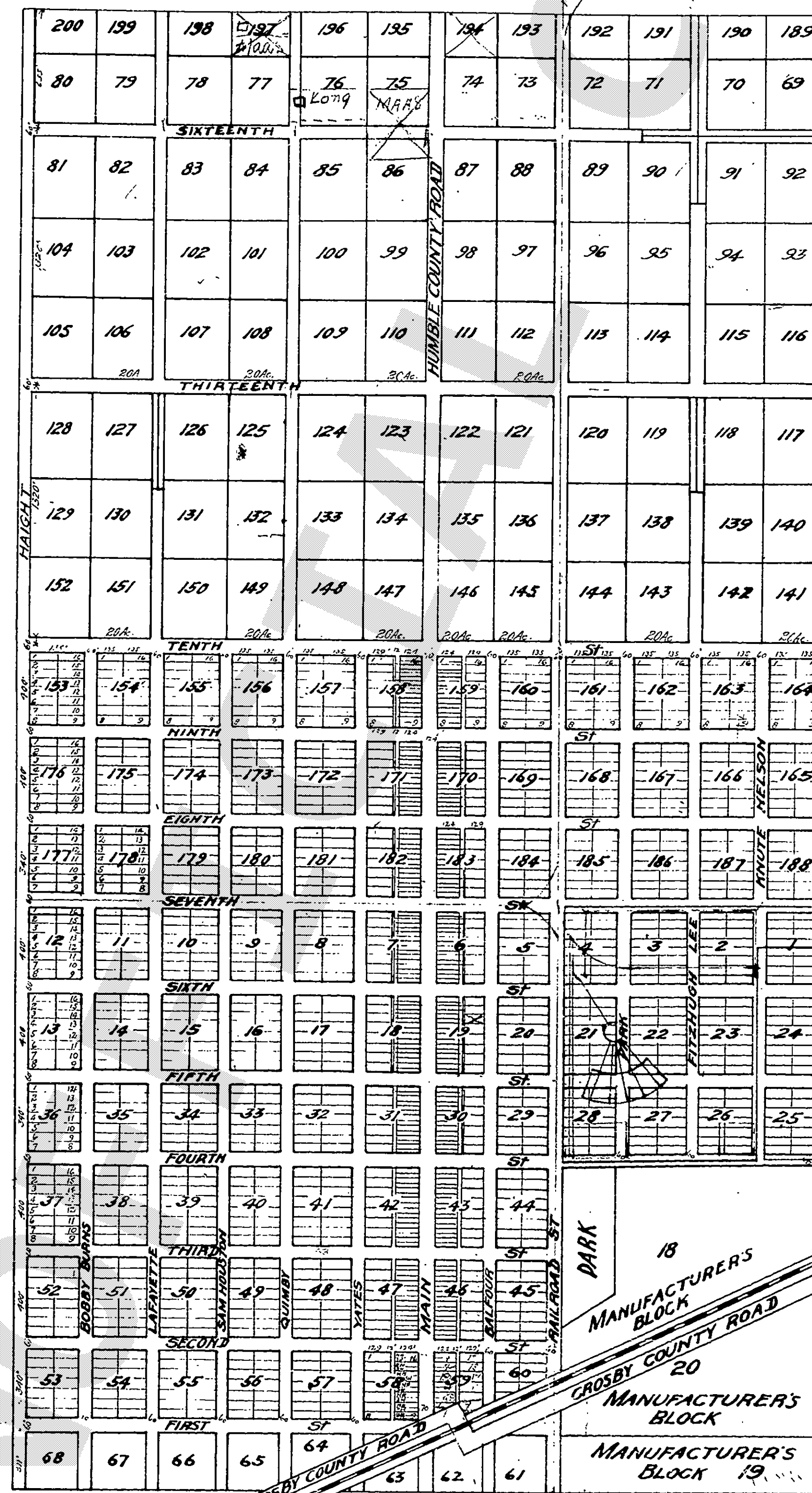

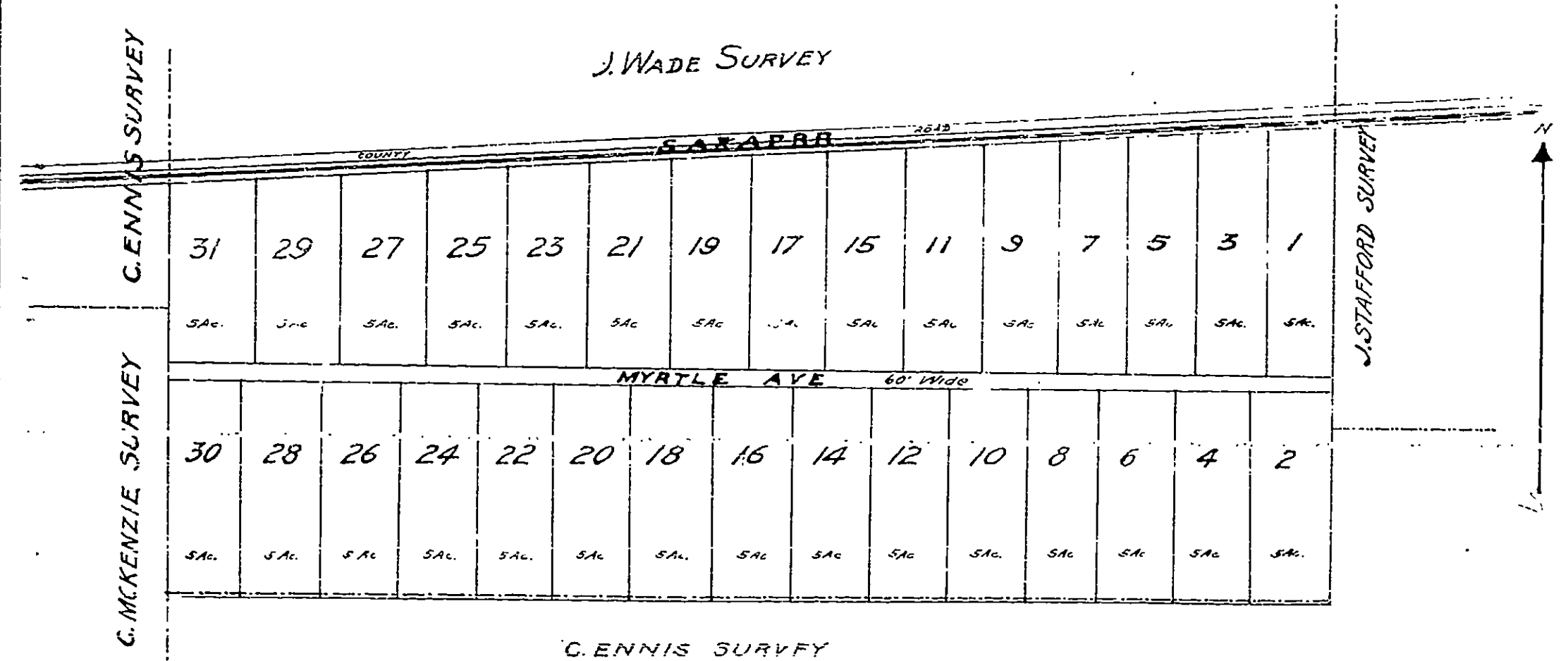

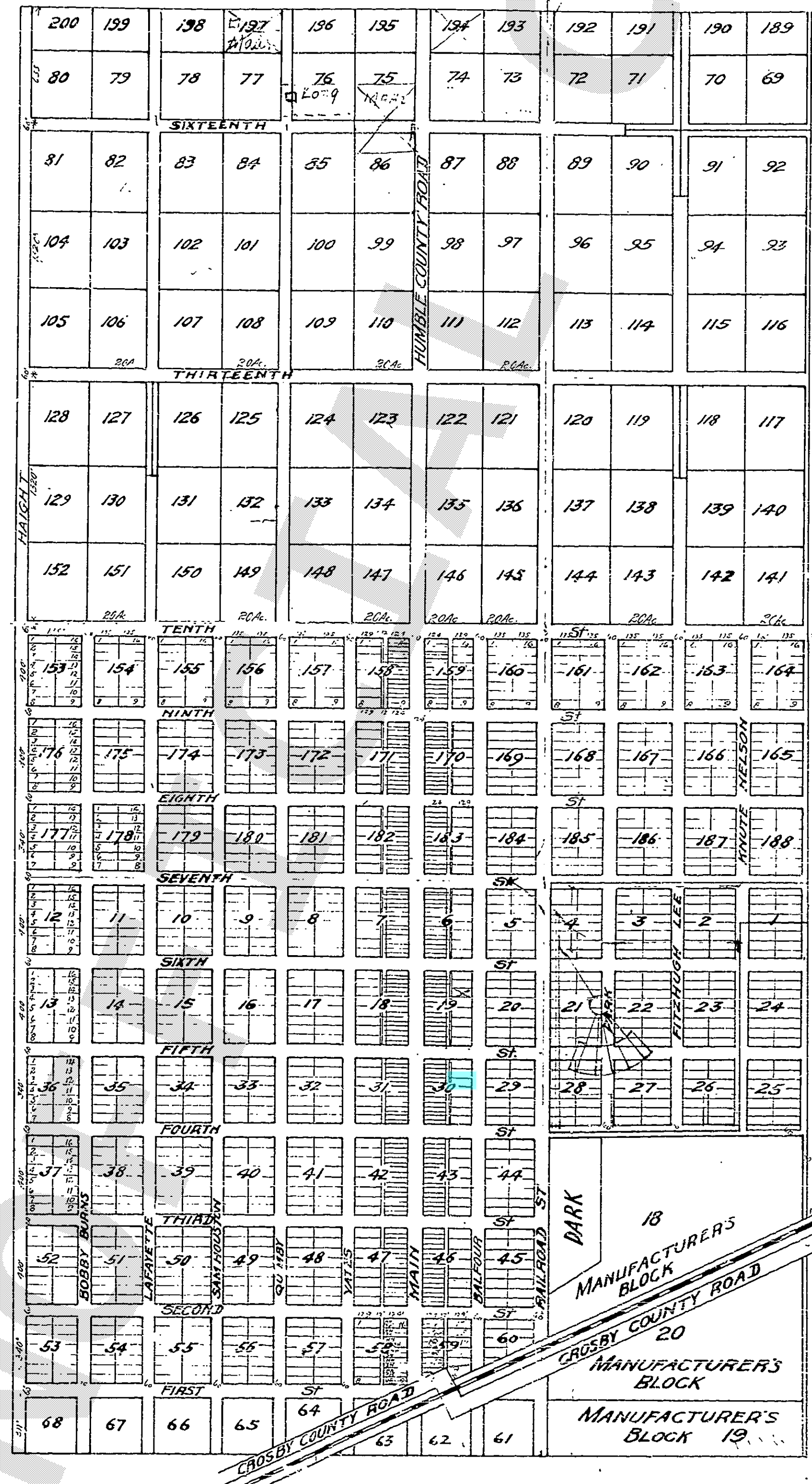
