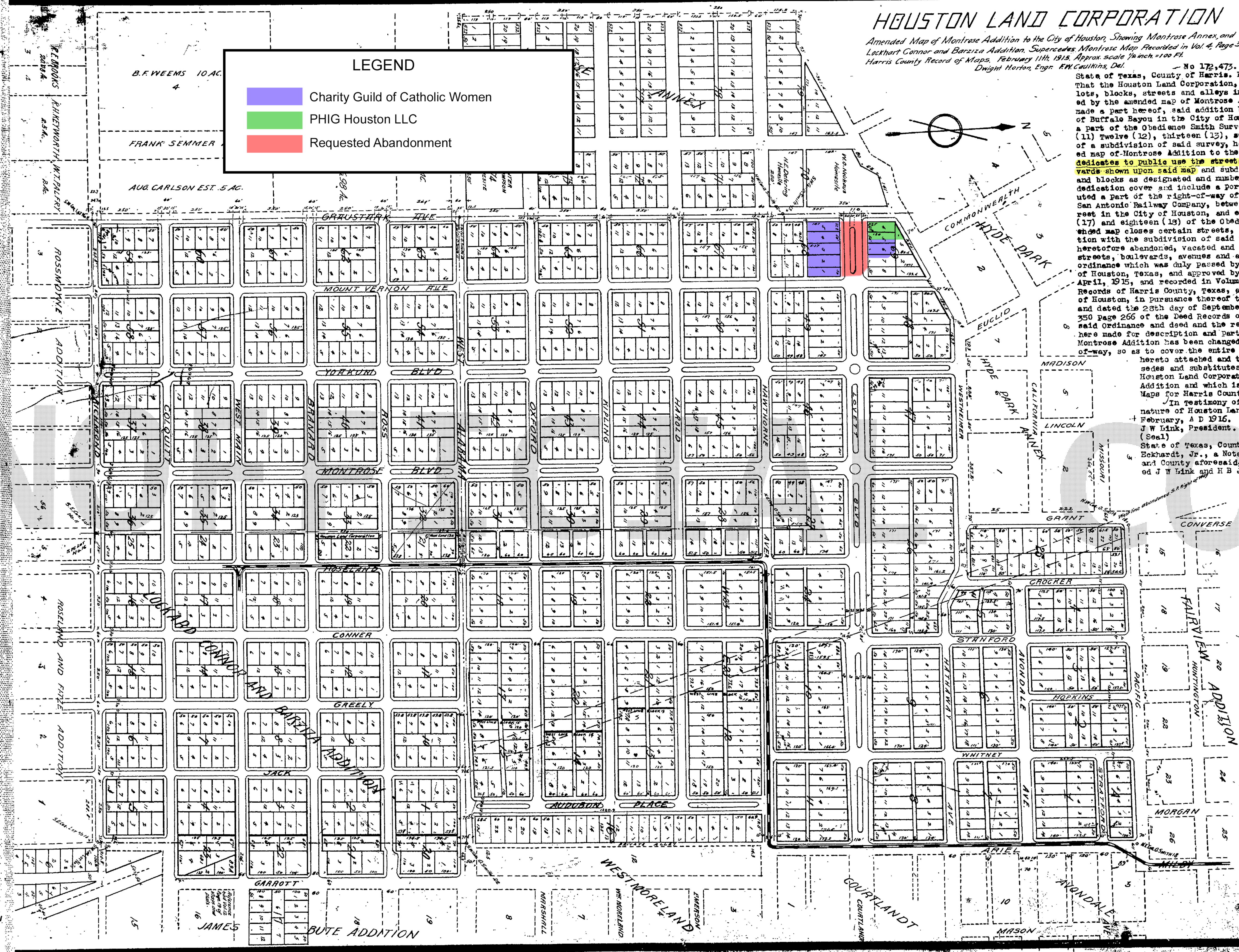

State of Texas, County of Harris. Know all men by these presents: That the Houston Land Corporation, being the owner of all the lots, blocks, streets and alleys in any manner changed or affected by the amended map of Montrose Addition, hereto attached and made a part hereof, said addition being located on the South Side of Buffalo Bayou in the City of Houston, Harris County, Texas, and a part of the Obedience Smith Survey and a part of lots eleven, (11) twelve, (12), thirteen, (13), seventeen, (17) and eighteen, (18) of a subdivision of said survey, hereby files for record an amended map of Montrose Addition to the City of Houston and hereby dedicates to public use the streets, alleys, avenues and boulevards shown upon said map and subdivides said land into city lots and blocks as designated and numbered upon said map. This map and dedication cover and include a portion of what formerly constituted a part of the right-of-way of the Galveston Harrisburg & San Antonio Railway Company, between Pacific Avenue and Main Street in the City of Houston, and extending through lots seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) of the Obedience Smith Survey and said amended map closes certain streets, avenues and alleys in connection with the subdivision of said right-of-way, which have been heretofore abandoned, vacated and closed, so as to conform to the streets, boulevards, avenues and alleys shown on this map, by an ordinance which was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Houston, Texas, and approved by the Mayor on the 15th day of April, 1915, and recorded in Volume 350, page 264 of the Deed Records of Harris County, Texas, and by a deed made by the City of Houston, in pursuance thereof to the Houston Land Corporation, and dated the 28th day of September, 1915, and recorded in Volume 350 page 266 of the Deed Records of Harris County, Texas, to which said Ordinance and deed and the records thereof, reference is here made for description and particulars. The corner map of said Montrose Addition has been changed, where affected by said right-of-way, so as to cover the entire territory shown in the map hereto attached and this map entirely covers, supersedes and substitutes the map or plat which said Houston Land Corporation heretofore filed of Montrose Addition and which is recorded in the Records of Maps for Harris County, Texas, in volume 4 on page 3.
